

Zero Hunger: Call to Action Stop Motion Video Assignment



We have explored causes and solutions for food insecurity. The last portion of this lesson will focus on creating stop motion videos as calls to action for food insecurity in Manitoba, or more specifically, in your home or school community.

Steps to completing your Food Insecurity Call to Action stop motion video assignment:

1. Select an approach to fighting food insecurity that you'll animate in your stop motion video. Be sure to let your teacher know once you've selected your topic.
2. Create a storyboard (a graphic representation of what will happen in your video) using the template provided to you on pages 2-4 of this document, then submit it for review by your teacher.
3. Construct your video set using materials provided to you in class or that you brought from home.
4. Download Stop Motion Studio App onto the iPad provided to you by the teacher or onto **one** of your group members' phones. Stabilize the phone or iPad by propping it up against something and/or taping it to the table so that it does not move.
5. Using the Stop Motion Studio App, move your figures (clay characters, Legos, etc.) very slightly and take photos in between each shot.
6. Record voice over your video to help tell your story (optional) and/or add music (also optional).

Details to Include in Your Stop Motion Video:

- The Issue: Why is it a problem?
- Who it Affects
- A Solution
